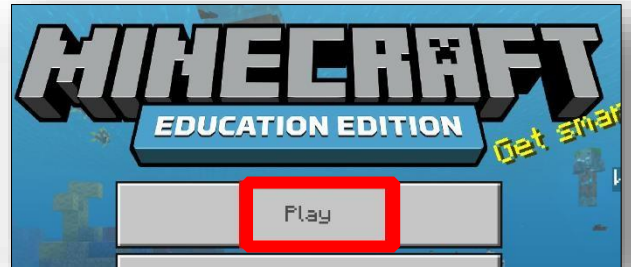


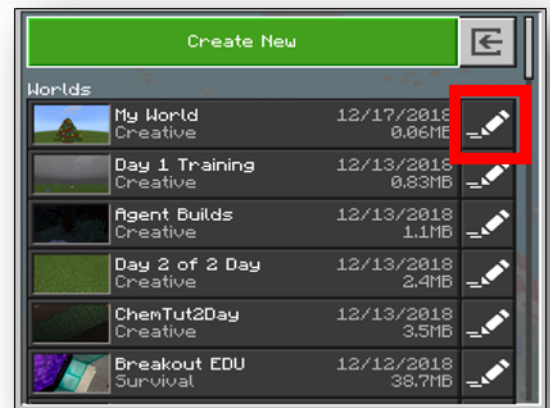
Minecraft: Exporting Worlds

Exporting Minecraft worlds is helpful when you need to work in worlds on different devices. Exporting a world will also ensure you have a back-up copy of the world.

1. Launch Minecraft, and sign in with your CCSD Office 365 account login and password.
2. Click **Play**.



3. Locate the name of the world you want to export and click **the pencil** next to the world's name.



4. Scroll to the bottom of the screen. Tap **Export**.
Choose a location for your world.



Note: On iPads, there must be an app downloaded on the iPad that can hold your world for you. Examples are: OneDrive and OneNote. To guide your app selection, consider why you are exporting the world and what will happen to the world when it is next opened.
