The following directions will show how to download the CCSD-issued SSL certificate from home. This process will make connecting your device at school quicker and easier. When the certificate is already installed, you will only need to connect to the wireless and log in when you get to school. This certificate is required for an error-free internet connection.

1. Open a web browser and navigate to http://bit.ly/certother or use the QR code.



- 2. When the popup window opens, select **Allow**.
- 3. In the next pop-up window, select **Close**.
- 4. Go back to the **Home** screen.
- 5. Select **Settings**.
- 6. Select **Profile Downloaded**.

7. **Install** the FortiGate Root Authority Profile.

- 13. Scroll down to **Certificate Trust Settings**.
- 14. Turn on the CCSD FortiGate Root Authority.
