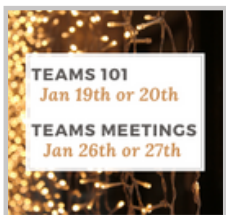

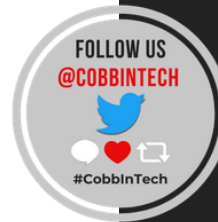
BULK PRINT REPORTS

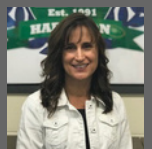
