

Connecting Personal Devices to the CCSD Guest Wireless Network (Windows 10)

The following are directions for connecting your <u>PERSONAL</u> Windows 10 device (Surface, Laptop) to the CCSD Guest Wireless Network.

1. From your device's desktop, select the **Wi-Fi** icon located on the bottom right of your screen.



2. Ensure that Wi-Fi is turned <u>ON</u>.



3. Select the **CCSDGuest** network, check the '*Connect Automatically*' box then click **Connect**.



4. You will need to enter the password provided by your local school's Library Media Specialist, Lab Manager, or School Administrator.

Once entered, press Next.



5. If Windows does not automatically launch a web session, open a web browser (i.e. Edge, Chrome Internet Explorer) and navigate to <u>www.cobbk12.org</u>.

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 If you have <u>NOT</u> registered for a Guest Account <u>DURING THE CURRENT SCHOOL YEAR</u>, select **New Guest**. If you received your Guest credentials during a previous visit, select **Returning Guest** and continue at Step 9.

Note: Guest Accounts MUST be renewed every year beginning July 1^{*st*}*.*





- 7. Complete all of the requested information consisting of:
 - The reason for a. requesting access
 - b. Your valid email address

- c. Your full name
- d. Your mobile phone number
- e. Your mobile service provider

Do not leave this site without first installing the CCSD-issued SSL Certificate!

It will be required to experience error-free surfing at secured HTTPS sites while on the CCSD Wireless Network.



11. Click **Save** to download and save the certificate to your local machine.





12. Click **Open** to launch the installer program.
